| Health Insurance | Incoming students are asked to send a copy of their EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) to the International Office (mail: io@eh-ludwigsburg.de) |
| Banking | Students should open a bank account because in Germany rent is paid through a bank account. The account is usually free of charge for students. |
| Student Union Fee | Approx. 100 Euros per semester. |
| Living Expenses in total | Approx. 700-800 Euros per month. |
