Herzlich Willkommen in Ludwigsburg!

The Protestant University of Applied Sciences in Ludwigsburg offers incoming students from our partner universities the opportunity to study with us during one semester. We offer classes in Social Work, Early Childhood Education, Deaconry, Religious Education, Nursing and Care, and Inclusive Pedagogy and Special Needs Education. At our university, you live and learn in an open and practice-oriented environment.

If you are capable to study in German, you may choose from all classes offered in the study course Nursing Care, gaining up to 30 credits. In addition to our classes taught in German, we plan to offer the following courses and practical experiences **in English** (changes and cancellation of individual courses are possible). You may choose any number of the offered courses (max. 30 ECTS total):

Practical placement (9/11 ECTS)

Students will conduct an either 7 or 8-week practical placement in an institution, e.g. hospital, ambulant/paediatric palliative care, training centre for home carers, drug addiction centres.

Support for life management: counselling, community service and pastoral care in international perspective (6 ECTS)

Students will acquire knowledge and skills of systemic conversation, different methodological approaches for contextual needs. They will have in-depth competence in systemic conversation management and their own professionally justified and reflected attitude in conversation with clients. This module consists of a seminar and a lecture.

International, intercultural and interreligious perspectives (6 ECTS)

In this module students will collect knowledge and learn to personal position themselves with regards to the history and present situation of Germany as a migration society. They will learn skills and develop the ability to reflect their own role against the background of an intercultural and diversity-oriented society. This will help the students to work professionally in a diverse, multicultural and interreligious world. This module consists of lectures, a specialisation seminar and a workshop.

Health promotion in international comparison (6 ECTS)

In this module students will learn about health and health promotion as a field of social work. They will get theoretical and practical input which will help them to understand how health and other personal and social conditions are connected and how health promotion can be implemented.

This module consists of a lecture and a mandatory elective seminar.

Nursing care and health care system in Germany (4 ECTS)

In a set of combined classes, students will learn about the profession of nursing care and the health care system in a German context, combining different approaches such as historical, political, medical perspectives.

Inclusion and exclusion from an international perspective (6 ECTS)

This module covers international inclusion / exclusion discourse, theories and legal bases of inclusion. Students will learn to understand inclusion and exclusion as the basis of social order and human coexistence and will be capable to create and reflect inclusive situations in their work context and to realise inclusive educational approaches.

This module consists of lectures and a mandatory seminar.
