<b>Letter of Acceptance</b>	The student will receive a letter of acceptance.

<b>Courses taught in English</b>	B2-level. We have a limited amount of courses offered in English, focused in our International Social Work program.
<b>German Language Courses</b>	We recommend students to participate in German language courses.

<b>Accommodation</b>	
<b>Student Housing</b>	The EH Ludwigsburg can nominate students for student housing. If you would like to be nominated, let us know at least four months before your arrival. There are two options: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Karlshöhe Ludwigsburg: There are shared flats for students which are located close to the campus as well as inclusive shared flats with either elders or people with impairments. Have a look at some of the flats <a href="#">here</a>.</li> <li>2. Student Association Stuttgart: They also offer several dormitories and student hostels in Stuttgart. <b>Health Insurance</b>	Incoming students are asked to send a copy of their EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) to the International Office ( <a href="mailto:incomings@ehludwigsburg.de">incomings@ehludwigsburg.de</a> ). <b>Banking</b>	Students should open a bank account because in Germany rent is paid through a bank account. The account is usually free of charge for students.
