Letter of Acceptance	The student will receive a letter of acceptance.

Karlshöhe Ludwigsburg: There are shared flats for students which are located close to the campus as well as inclusive shared flats with either elders or people with impairments. Frequently Asked Questions	
Health Insurance	Incoming students are asked to send a copy of their EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) to the International Office (incomings@ehludwigsburg.de). For Incomings from outside the European Union please see the Infosheet regarding Health Insurance!
Banking	Students should open a bank account because in Germany rent is paid through a bank account. The account is usually free of charge for students.
Student Union Fee	Approx. 100 Euros per semester.
Living Expenses in total	Approx. 1000 Euros per month.
